Who We Serve



Mentorship, Intervention, and Collaborative Learning.
KOPMN mentoring programs inspire youth to envision a prosperous future.

KOPMN PROGRAMS ARE DESIGNED FOR:

- Children aged 7 to 17 in South Florida.
- Many of our students are from low socio-economic backgrounds attending Title One schools and are eligible for free or reduced-cost lunches in impoverished areas of South Florida.
- On average, KOPMN serves over 2,000 youth and their families annually.
- In addition to mentoring and academic services, KOPMN offers transportation for programs and provides nutritious meals and snacks for students, mentees, and campers.

REFERRAL PROGRAMS:

- KOPMN accepts referrals from principals, educators, teachers, and peers and maintains an ongoing waiting list for services. Historically, referrals have also come from the court system (judges) and police officers as part of a comprehensive diversion process.
- Once a referral and application to the program are submitted, each young person is interviewed by a panel of current participants, who collectively decide on admission to the program.



Children who rely on free or reduced lunches throughout the academic year often lack access to these essential services during school breaks and the summer months. KOPMN's programs bridge this gap by offering healthy meals and snacks during these periods..



KOPMN mentorship and intervention programs offer mentees essential guidance, resources, and opportunities to thrive.


Where We Serve

Program Description



Through the KOPMN mentoring, academic, and camp experiences, our students are guided along an exciting path of exploration and discovery.

KOPMN MENTORING PROGRAMS:

- KOPMN mentoring programs stand out, offering a comprehensive approach to combating the effects of poverty, truancy, recidivism, and delinquency.
- **KOPMN instills in our youth** the understanding that **knowledge** liberates, commands respect, builds self-esteem and enables them to have a positive attitude about their life choices. **Opportunity** opens the doors of opportunity for our youth to hear from and interact with a diverse group of experts. We take pride in our ability to help every child develop his or her talents regardless of their circumstances. KOPMN chooses **prosperity** because as mentors, we point the way, raise the bar and expand children's understanding of what is possible. No one flourishes alone, any more than an acorn can become an oak tree without soil, water, and sunshine.
- **Our programs strengthen families** by reinforcing family involvement, recognizing it as a crucial component throughout the application and enrollment processes.
- **KOPMN requires school participation:** To participate, young individuals must attend school regularly. The KOPMN program serves as an incentive for school engagement as appropriate class conduct is required to continue in the program.
- **Use of evidence-based strategies:** KOPMN's comprehensive truancy and delinquency prevention initiative provides effective programming while offering STREAM (science, technology, recreation, engineering, arts, and mathematics) learning opportunities, along with high school and college readiness training. We incorporate dynamic STREAM camps and programs, including aviation, communication and multimedia, guided physical activities, financial literacy, music and arts, horticulture, and mental health and wellness support, among others.
- **Each program emphasizes social-emotional learning, academic success, and pre-career development** for youth to cultivate a positive mindset to thrive and look forward to a brighter future.

KOPMN's programs engage youth with compassionate mentors who serve as advocates and role models. Our mentors work directly with teachers and school counselors to monitor and encourage school attendance while discouraging truancy and negative behaviors. KOPMN is a character-building, mentorship and gang prevention initiative aimed at fostering leadership, academic success and civic-mindedness among youth ages 7 to 17.



STREAM CAMPS

MUSIC & THE ARTS

STREAM (science, technology, recreation, engineering, arts, and mathematics) Camps offer engaging learning experiences that align with principles and learning for all grade levels. Camps create enriching indoor and outdoor field trip opportunities, teaching the youth we serve about civic-mindedness, environmental stewardship, real-world challenges, critical thinking, and hands-on learning.

(Note: All camps provide campers with nutritious meals and snacks).

Mentoring through Music and Art Camps integrates mentorship with music, art, photography, and writing. This vibrant five-day multicultural camp accommodates 30 campers, offering an educational experience that sparks creativity in a fun group setting. Instructors use interactive, hands-on learning techniques to improve communication, leadership, and teamwork skills. Campers develop and build their skills.

CAMP QUEST

Camp Quest is a nine-week summer camp centered around STREAM learning that offers enriching indoor and outdoor activities designed to spark curiosity, ignite a passion for learning, and equip children with essential skills vital for their future. Campers engage in a variety of activities, including aviation, equine, marine science, kayaking, fishing, arts, underwater robotics, biking, camping, science, hiking, boating, sports, yoga, golf, swimming, snorkeling, gardening, visiting parks, interacting with animals, playing board games, cooking, shopping, and developing emotional intelligence.

CAMP IMAGINATION

Camp Imagination combines key childhood development elements such as leadership, respect, teamwork, confidence, self-esteem, memory, creativity, coordination.

Activities Feature:

Kids Fitness Zumba, an engaging program tailored for children. This activity promotes age-appropriate games that improve coordination, boosts self-confidence, helps campers conquer fears, encourages teamwork, and provides numerous additional benefits.

Spring BREAK CAMP

This multicultural camp provides 30 campers with a variety educational, creative, musical, and engaging experiences that inspire them in a fun group environment. Instructors use interactive, hands-on learning techniques to improve, leadership, communication, and teamwork skills, all while ensuring that the learning process is enjoyable!



Blues CAMP

The Fernando Jones Blues Camp International This fun-filled week of Blues immersion engages 30 students through ensemble instruction and public performances.

Participants learn America's "root" music in a structured program under the tutelage of qualified and internationally traveled instructors. The program inspires beginner, intermediate, and advanced level vocalists and instrumentalists, ages 7 to 17, to be curious about the world and become globally aware. By understanding and respecting similarities and differences, campers gain a deeper understanding of their identity in the context of race, ethnic group, culture, religion, language, and family history. This program also enriches their knowledge of the world around them with meaningful information they will not forget. The camp is conducted annually in 21 cities across the US, Cuba, and Japan.

Communications & Multimedia



Empowering Communities through Service and Media Outreach. *Community Conversations* is dedicated to enhancing social-emotional health, education, career opportunities, networking with community leaders, and addressing police-community relations.

SOCIAL: We organize *Community Conversations* weekly—an hour-long forum that allows young people to interact with community leaders and newsmakers, asking the questions that are important to them. To date, participants have included the chief of police, the vice mayor, three school board members, a psychologist, a judge, a medical doctor, and others.



Only in South Florida, young individuals have the unique opportunity to report the day's news that resonates with their peers. The live remote-style human-interest program, *Community Conversations*, serves as a safe space for kids to engage in discussions about topics that matter to them. The Soaring Eagles is a hands-on, interactive mentoring and STREAM program that encourages elementary and middle school students to develop a love for learning. Our program is designed to introduce these kids to the world of aviation and help them grow into well disciplined, educated members and leaders of their communities.



Weekly themes take students across the world and throughout time as they become investigators and problem solvers. Topics include Simulator Training, What Makes Airplanes Fly? History, Science, and Applications of Aerodynamics. Soaring Eagles is open to young boys and girls with an interest in learning more about careers in the field of aviation. The program encourages elementary and middle school students to develop a love for learning through applying STEM principals to the discipline of aviation and flight using field trips, guided tours, and classroom exercises. Soaring Eagles combines exciting hands-on activities with interactions with aviation professionals representing a wide range of careers.

Youth experience first-hand what it is like to be a pilot, aircraft mechanic, flight engineer, or air traffic controller. Through engaging hands-on activities—including aircraft building projects, attending aviation shows, training in meteorology, navigation, airmanship, flight simulator lessons, tours of airports and aviation facilities, and networking with aviation professionals—youth develop flying knowledge, learn aviation protocols, and develop vital leadership and teamwork skills. Using Roberts Rules of Order, youngsters manage the program and hone their leadership skills in business meetings, followed by an hour of aviation training. Technology has allowed KOPMN to also include workshop speakers and trainers who would not have been able to join us physically, but who can provide services using remote platforms from wherever they are located. **KOPMN plans to add drone and sea-plane training to this program as engaging activities for young people.**


Equine Studies

TIME TO THRIVE

Operational Highlights

We are committed to empowering the next generation of innovators.

College Tours and Educational Trips: KOPMN provided opportunity for high school students and chaperones to tour Florida Atlantic University, Florida Memorial University, Florida International University, Florida A&M University, Florida State University, and Bethune Cookman University over Spring Break. Additionally, children were able to attend the Florida Atlantic University football game and homecoming. These experiences broadened the horizons of our youth, exposing them to new academic environments and opportunities that they might not have otherwise encountered promoting higher education.

Multi-generational Holiday Happiness: Seniors and students worked together to experience each holiday (Hanukkah, Christmas, and Kwanzaa). The sessions included guest speakers who shared historical events and explained how and why people celebrate each holiday. The sessions ended with participants making a craft, treat, or gift to represent the holiday. During the week of Kwanzaa, students performed a poem to represent one of the principles of Kwanzaa at the Blues Camp performance.

Palm Beach Has Talent: This monthly talent show provided youth across Palm Beach County an opportunity to showcase their talents and prepare for future entertainment careers. Talent was judged by professional artists, including educators and newsmakers. The monthly event included a fun dance session and additional talent, such as a comedian who energized the crowd for the evening. Monetary prizes were awarded to the winners, who also had the opportunity to perform at events around the county.

Camp Quest: KOPMN delivered a nine-week STREAM-focused summer camp to children in eastern Palm Beach County. The camp was a resounding success, immersing campers in aviation, equine science, marine science, the arts, underwater robotics, and emotional intelligence. These enriching activities sparked curiosity, ignited a passion for learning, and equipped the children with essential skills for their future endeavors.

2024 Fernando Jones Blues Kids Camp in Palm Beach: 21 students from south, central, and north Palm Beach County had the opportunity to learn about America's root music under the direction of a team of industry professionals. Participants engaged in a variety of activities, including instrumental instruction, ensemble rehearsals, and masterclasses led by experienced blues musicians.

Additionally, we aim to expand our community partnerships and alliances, which will enhance current prospects for mentees, mentors, and the communities we support, all while motivating youth through civic engagement. **Our kickoff was during National Mentoring Month (January).**

Opportunities: The learning experiences of our mentees significantly enhance their social-emotional health, mathematics skills, language arts, and future academic performance. Building on this success, we aim to further enhance student engagement through innovative initiatives that provide a diverse range of STEAM learning, and an introduction to healthcare professionals, including dentists, pharmacists, physicians, nurses, healthcare executives, research scientists, biomedical engineers, pharmaceutical representatives, medical device specialists, and other emerging roles within the healthcare sector. We believe that by fostering these meaningful connections, we can collectively make a significant and synergistic impact on the health and well-being of our mentees. We can ensure our youth have access to high-quality mentoring and STREAM programs to foster their success in school and beyond. Programs will include weekly enrichment activities, community conversation, and experiences ranging from fishing trips to attending Presidential Inaugurations **to build confidence and to empower.**
